- Held membership for a total of 51yrs. joined the club in 1961

The Nippers State Titles are returning closer to home next season and will be held at Ocean Beach, Umina - 1st, 2nd and 3rd March 2013. We know this will mean that a lot of our families will want to come along for this great weekend of competition made even more special by our famous South Curly Mess Tent and us all being together for daily debriefs!

I know we are just moving into Nippers headspace but we require an expression of interest for this carnival NOW.

We have managed to secure accommodation across the road from the carnival location Ocean Beach at Ocean Beach Holiday Park. The accommodation ranges from townhouses to powered camp sites. Please indicate if you think you would be interested in attending this weekend away and if so what accommodation would most suit you and your family. We have been allocated accommodation for 120 people and pricing has been based on all beds being filled ie. at this stage cabins sleeping 5 cannot be booked solely by a family of 3 – we will need to fill the other beds. Depending on the numbers interested in attending this may change and prices may increase.

Ocean Beach Holiday Park - www.oceanbeachholidaypark.com.au. Our prices for accommodation are approximate and are based on a min. 3 night stay.

20 x Powered Tent Site - approx. \$200 per site for 3 nights.

9 x Cabins - sharing with other club members to fill all beds - approx. \$150 per person for 3 nights

4 x Family Townhouse - \$995 per townhouse for 3 nights

Accommodation Descriptions:

Powered Tent Site - The powered camp sites in the Sunnyside area have turf and each site now has a Camp Pad which allows the sand to filter through. Approx site dimensions are 8m x 8m (26 feet).

Seabreeze Villa - 3 bedrooms (2 queen beds, 2 sets of bunks), bathroom and ensuite, spacious dining and kitchen, verandah. Air conditioning * Laundry * 2 TVs with Foxtel and DVD * Sleeps 8 (max 6 adults)

Playground Cabin - 2 bedrooms (Queen bed + 3 or 4 bunk beds), air conditioning, sitting area, bathroom with shower and toilet (some with baths) * Full kitchen, TV with Foxtel * Some cabins sleep 6, others sleep 5 (both max 4 adults)

Seabreeze Townhouse - 2 bedroom (Queen Bed, 1 double bunk and single bed), double storey * spacious bathroom * Full kitchen, air conditioning * 2 TVs with Foxtel and DVD * Laundry facilities * Separate toilet upstairs * Hairdryer * Decks on both levels * Sleeps 5 (max 4 adults)
